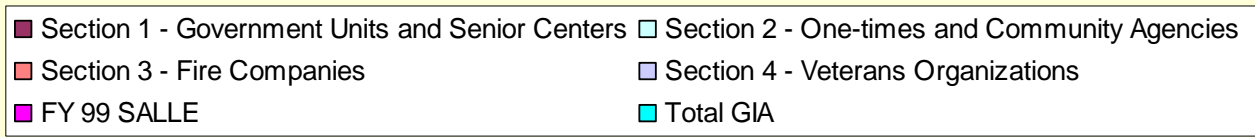
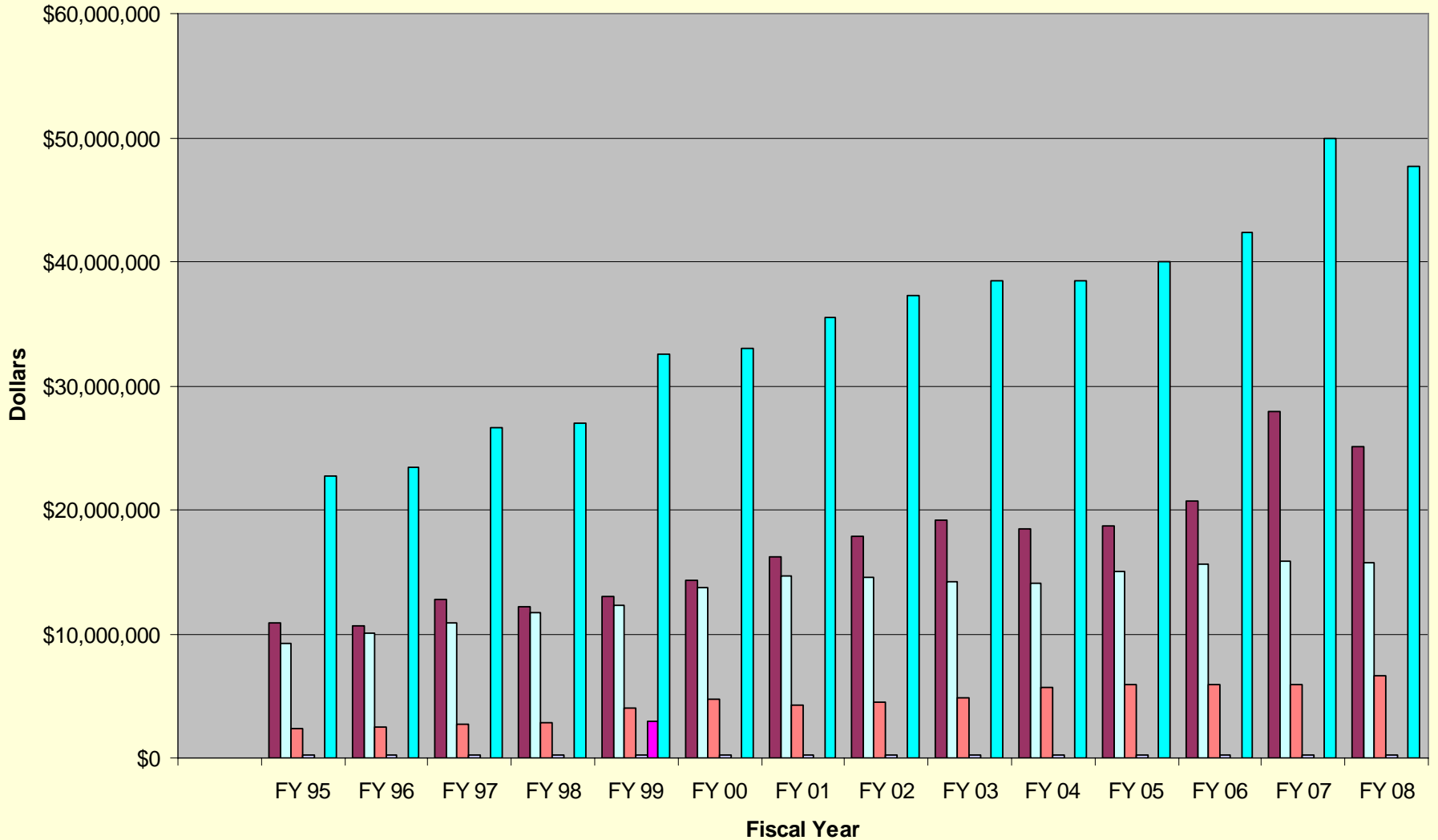
Grants-in-Aid Background

- Annual Appropriation via Act of the General Assembly
- Contains four sections:
 - Government Units and Senior Centers
 - One-Times and Community Agencies
 - Aging/Other
 - Arts/Historical/Cultural/Tourism
 - Handicapped/Health/Labor
 - Family and Youth Services
 - Alcohol/Drug Abuse
 - Neighborhood/Community Services
 - Fire Companies
 - Veterans Organizations

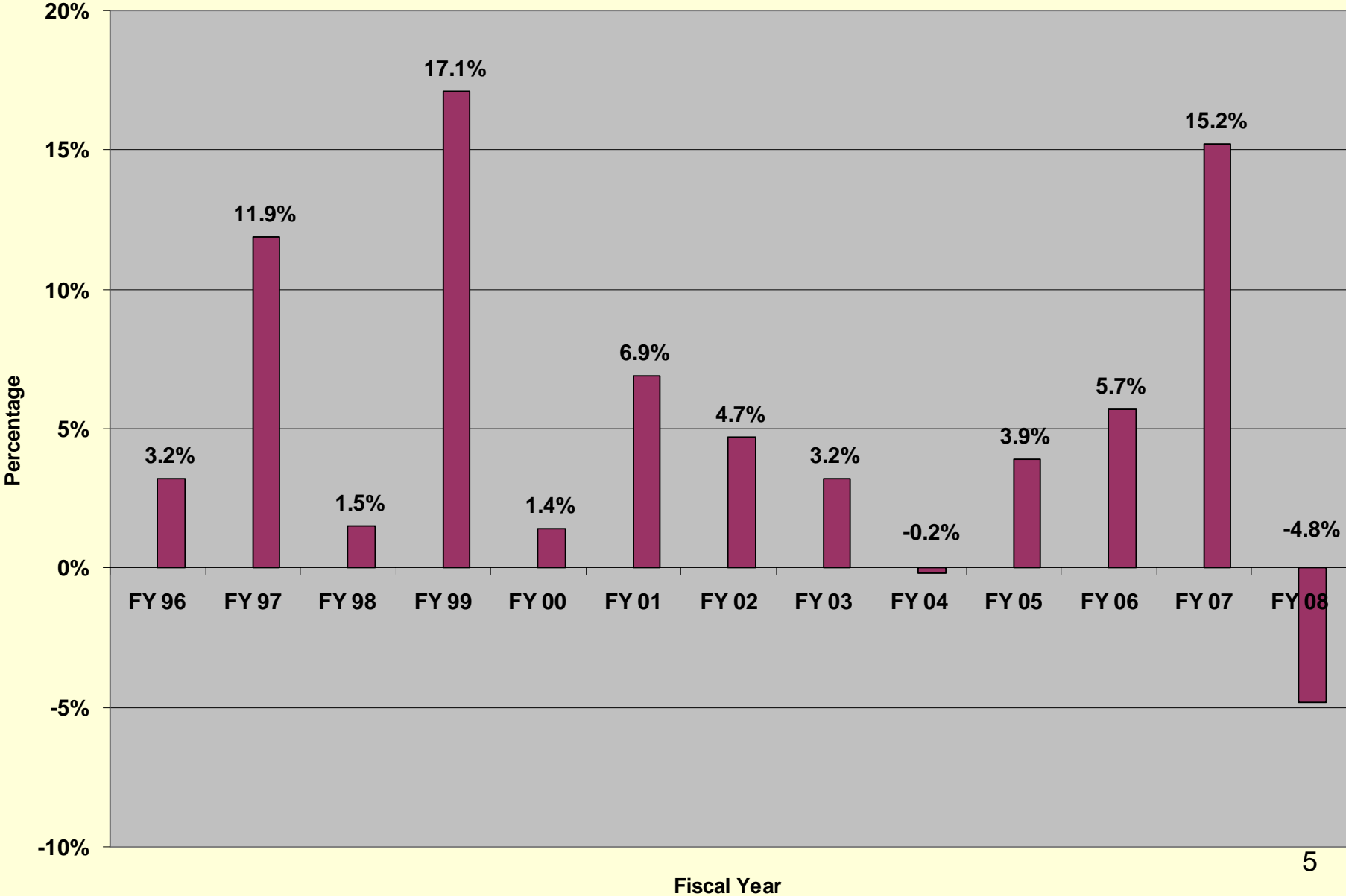
Guidelines for Application

- No funds will be appropriated for Child Day Care
- No funds will be appropriated for Capital costs
- Applicant must meet all requirements included in the application package:
 - Incorporated as a non-profit for at least 2 years
 - Corporate by-laws
 - Active Board of Directors
 - Personnel policies
 - Fiscal policies
 - Demonstrates Community Support
- Applications are due by November 1st Annually to be considered for the upcoming fiscal year
- Annual Audit must accompany the application

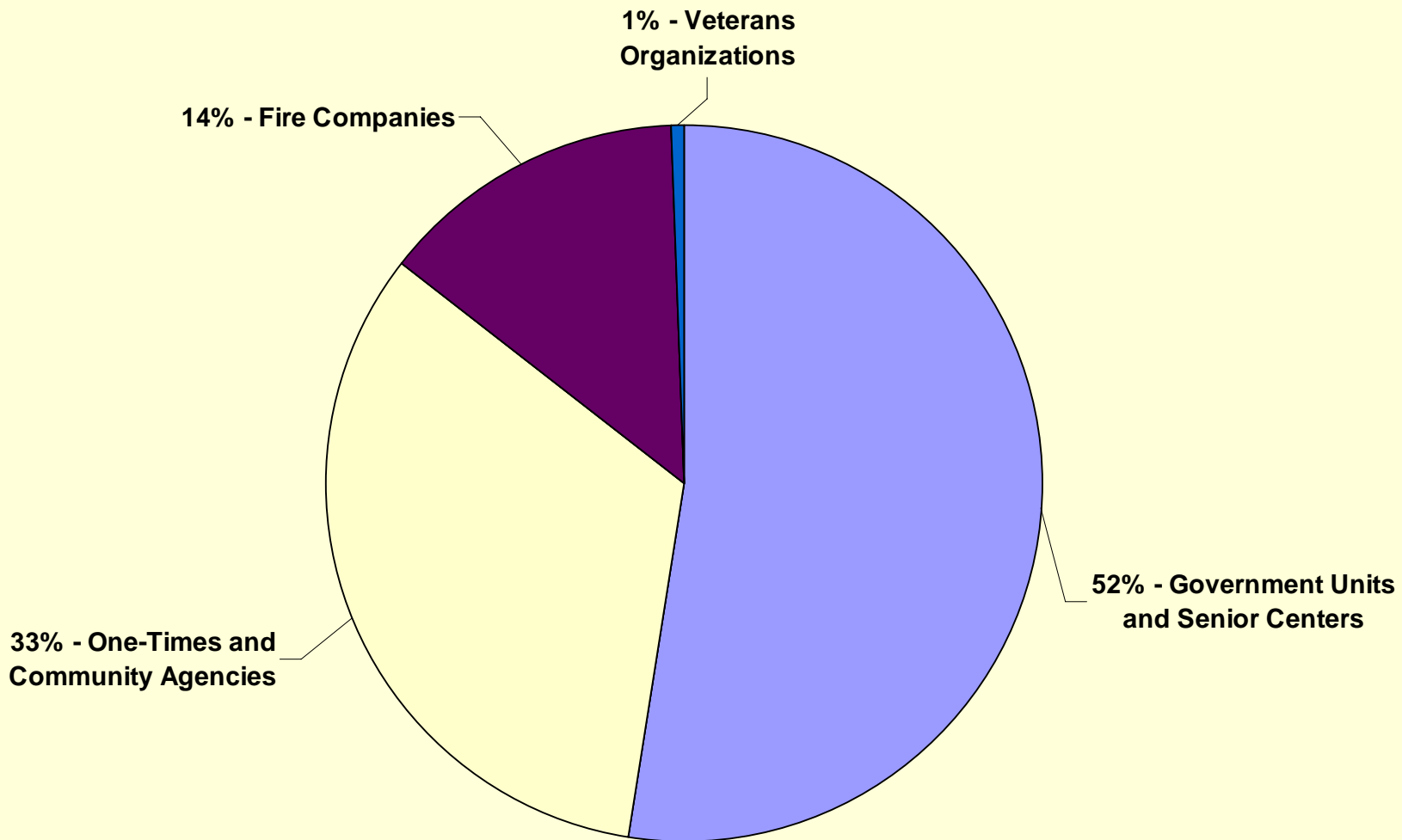
Grants-in-Aid Annual Funding



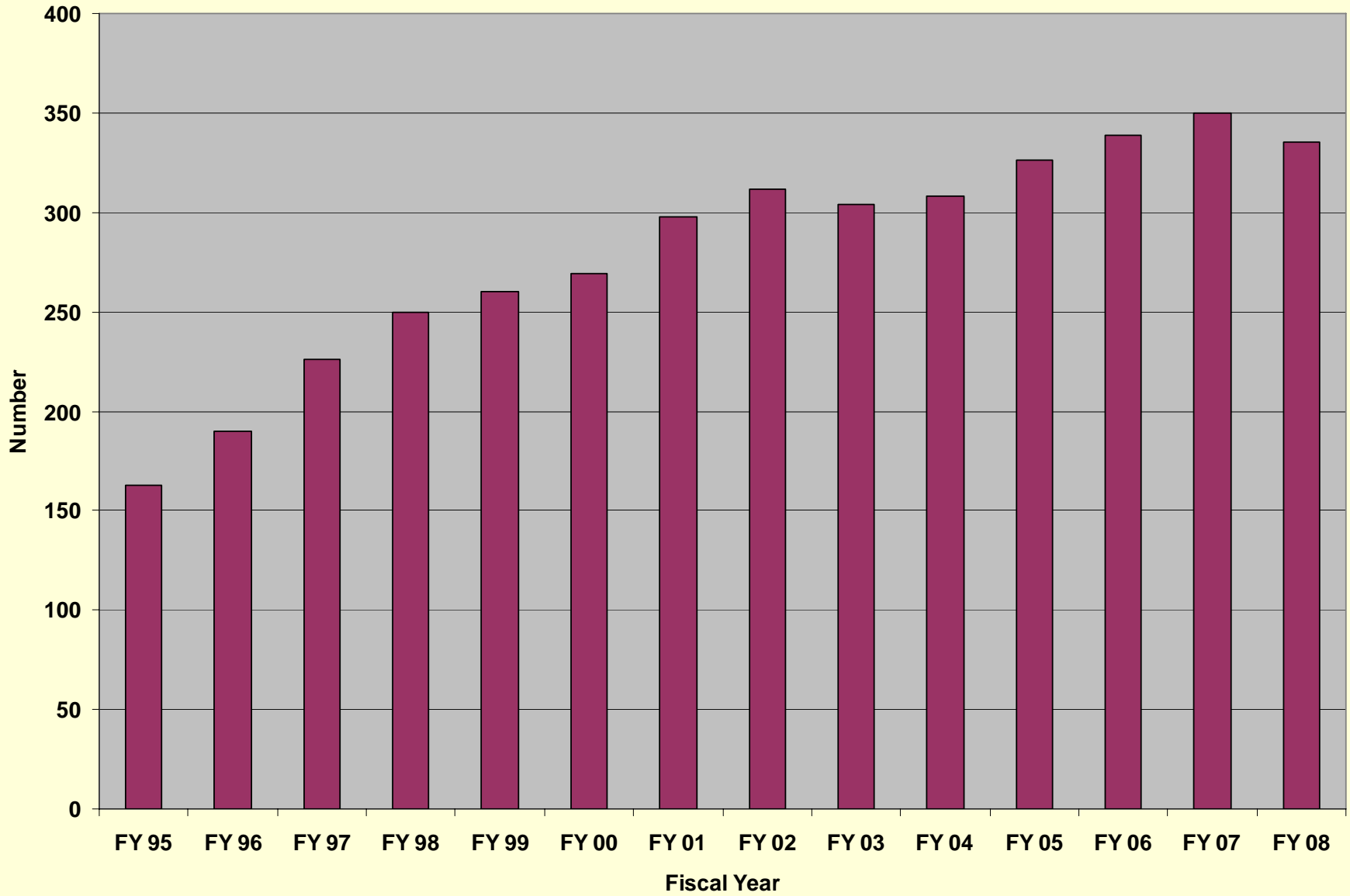
GIA - Annual Growth Rate %
